Morning (3 hours) - Engaging Students in Expository Text

This session will focus on the components of reading comprehension and strategies that help students learn from content area textbooks. We'll examine text structures and strategies that help students become more successful in reading texts. Hands-on activities will illustrate the effectiveness of these strategies.

Afternoon (2 hours) - Understanding Struggling Readers

This presentation will provide an overview of the varying needs of struggling readers & recommendations for helping them. Dr. Irvin will present a case study of a struggling reader and examine seven prototypes of non-proficient readers, and methods teachers can use to help them.
